- 1. **Summer School Instructional Materials**: We will offer summer school for identified students for additional learning opportunities. Planned Amount: \$5,000 Total for 21-22;22-23;23-24 School Years..
- 2. **Summer School Teachers**: Funds will help compensate for additional days worked to fill in learning loss associated with COVID disruption. Planned Amount: \$36,000 Total for 21-22;22-23;23-24 School Years.
- 3. **Provide Mental Health Services and Supports**: Purchase Curriculum for Counselor. Planned Amount: \$4350 Total for 21-22;22-23;23-24 School years.
- 4. **Interventionists to Address Learning Loss**: Interventionists Will Work with At-Risk Students Due to Learning Loss Caused By Pandemic: Planned Amount: \$170,000 Total for 21-22;22-23;23-24 School Years.
- 5. **Region 15 ESSER Contract Assistance**: Planned Amount: \$6,784 Total for 21-22;22-23;23-23 School Years.
- 6. **Teacher Retention Stipends:** To Help Encourage Staff to Remain in The Field of Education Despite Significant Challenges Brought on By the Pandemic: Planned Amount \$183,854 Total for 21-22;22-23;23-24 School Years.
- 7. **Supplies to Sanitize and Clean:** Contract with Vendor to Disinfect Entire Facilities with Equipment and Chemicals to Reduce the Spread of Infectious Diseases. Planned Amount: \$13,236 Total for the 22-23;23-24 School Years.
- 8. **Replace HVAC Systems:** To Improve Air Quality and Ventilation to Reduce the Spread of Infectious Diseases in Response to The Pandemic. Planned Amount:\$100,000. Replace 6 HVAC Systems.
- 9. **Replace Exterior Doors:** To Improve Air Ventilation to Reduce the Spread of COVID. Planned Amount: \$3,150 during the 21-22 School Year.
