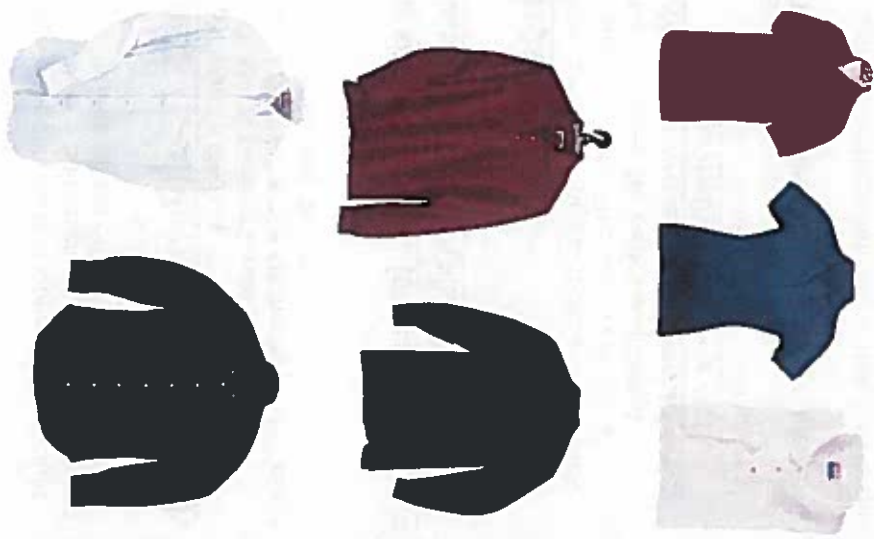


## Shirts

White, Maroon, or Navy (Must be a solid color)

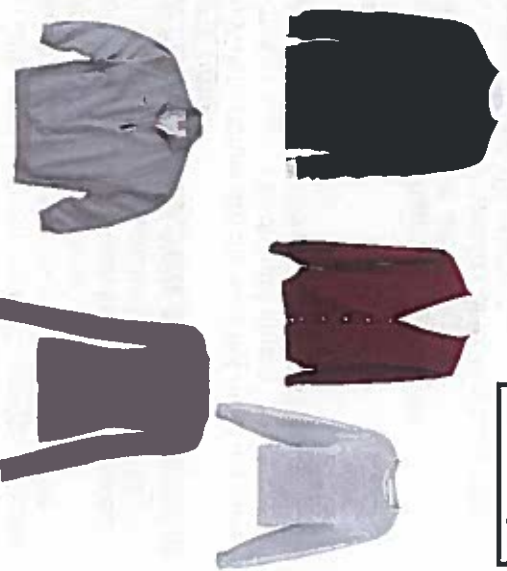
- a) Short or long-sleeve solid color polo, turtleneck or Oxford type with collar
- b) Must be buttoned to within 2 buttons from the top
- c) All shirts must be tucked in while at school
- d) Preferably – no logos on shirts



## Undershirts

White, Maroon, Gray or Navy (Must be a solid color)

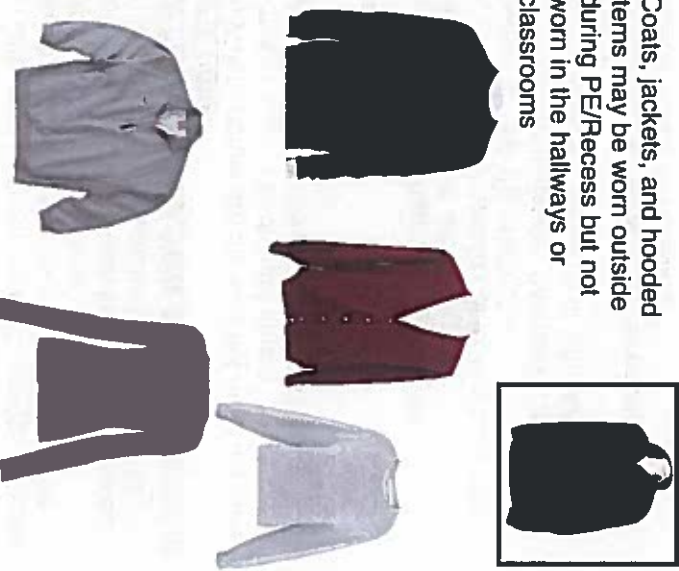
- a) Short or long sleeves shirts and turtlenecks can be worn under the collared uniform shirt but must be white, maroon or navy



## Sweaters/Sweatshirts

Navy, Maroon, Gray, or White Cardigan sweaters, fleece jackets, sweatshirts are allowed to be worn at all times (Must be solid color)

- a) Must be worn over a collared standard attire
- b) Collar must be visible
- c) Cannot have hoodie or drawstrings (Must be banded at waist)
- d) One size rule enforced



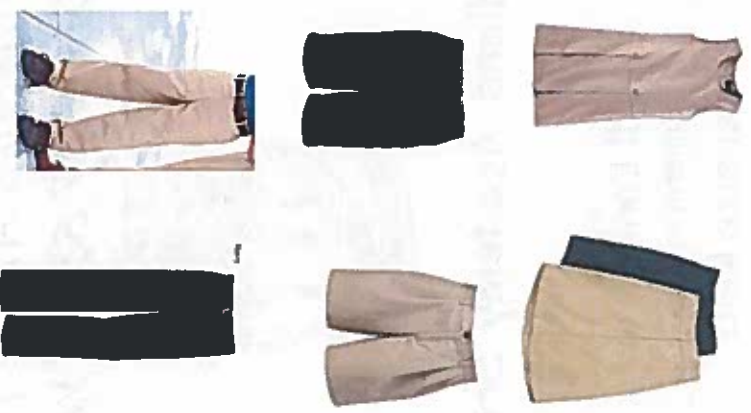
Coats, jackets, and hooded items may be worn outside during PE/Recess but not worn in the hallways or classrooms

## Pants/Shorts/Skirts/

### Jumpers

Navy or Khaki (Tan color)

- a) Garments are to be fitted and not baggy. **SAGGING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.** One-size rule will be enforced
- b) No ripped, torn, or clothing with holes; garments must be hemmed
- c) Skirts and shorts can only be 3 inches above the knee (includes the slit on skirts)
- d) Girls may wear leggings/tights under skirts (3 inch rule applies) but they must be solid maroon, white or navy.
- e) Leggings may not be worn alone.



## Belts

- a) Must be black or brown without jewels or metal beading
- b) If garment has belt loops, student must wear a belt (excluding Pre-K) belt loops cannot be cut off



## MACS T-Shirt/College Shirt

- a) **EVERY FRIDAY**  
MACS T-shirt/Sweatshirt
- b) **FIRST MONDAY Of the MONTH** - College T-shirts may be worn

## "One size rule" applies. (one size larger than actual measurement to allow for growth)

## Shoes

- a) Must be closed toed and closed heel back and appropriate for Recess and Physical Education Class. No Sandals allowed.

### Students are encouraged to wear

#### Tennis/Athletic Shoes daily.

- b) No shoes with wheels or lights are allowed
- c) Shoelaces must remain tied
- d) Boots are allowed but must be changed for PE
- e) High heeled footwear (more than 2 inches) is not allowed

## Socks and Hosiery

### White, Black, or Navy (Solid Color)

- a) Socks or Hosiery must be worn at all times regardless of shoe type

## Accessories & Jewelry

- a) Girls may wear simple stud earrings (one per ear) that do not hang from ear. Boys cannot wear earrings at any time.
- b) No piercing other than in the ear is allowed
- c) Make-up is not permitted in PreK-5<sup>th</sup> Grade
- d) **Fake/Artificial Nails are not allowed at any time**
- e) Wristwatches are allowed but must not have lights or sounds to distract others
- g) Tattoos and body glitter is not allowed

## Hair

- a) Must be kept neat and out of eyes
- b) No facial hair is allowed
- c) For boys, hair should not extend below the jawline or over the shirt collar
- d) No drastic hairstyles (Mohawks, shaved letters/numbers, designs) or Unnatural hair colors)
- e) Bandana-styled headbands or caps are not allowed inside the building

## Availability of Standard Attire

Most local clothing stores carry many brands of clothing that match the above-mentioned Standard Attire requirements.

### Buyer Beware

Most local clothing stores also carry many brands and styles that are not allowed within the Standard Attire requirements.
